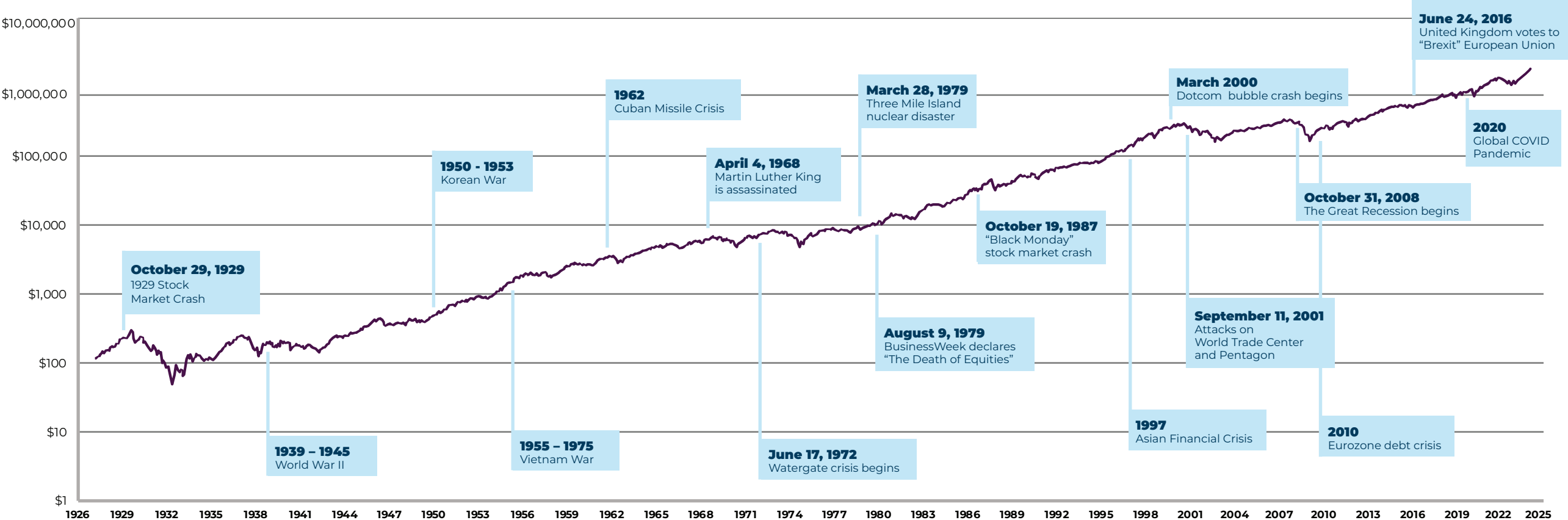


Growth of a \$100 if invested in the SBBI® US Large Stock Index (1926 - 2025)
